Existing roads: Indicated on Map I.

Planned access roads: Indicated on Map I.

Lateral roads to well location: Indicated on Map I.
5.
Location of tank batteries and flow lines: Indicated on Map I.
6.
Location and type of water supply: Fresh water to be hauled by trucks from Crossroads, New Mexico, 12 miles to east.
7.
Method for handling waste disposal: Solid trash and garbage burned in pit; cuttings buried in pits when leveled. Produced salt water will be run through line paralleling road to well to south and eventually disposed of in a New Mexico Salt Water Company disposal well.

Location of camp: None
9.
Location of air strip: None
10.
Rig layout, etc.: See Plat I
11.
Surface restoration: Pits will be dried and then spread and leveled; roads and pads left for ranchers and operations use.

Miscellaneous Information: Topography is flat without major drainage; no cutting or filling will be needed for roads or location. Vegetation is a semi-arid flora used for cattle grazing.
