BTA Oil Producers proposes to drill the 689-C Ltd Hugh Lease, Well #5, Bagley, North (Penn.) Field, Lea County, New Mexico, at the following location:

Unit Letter "L", Section 6, Township 12-S,  
Range 33-E, 510' FWL & 1980' FSL

Field rules for the Bagley, North (Penn) Field requires 80 acres to be assigned to a standard unit, but also provides for sub-standard development. Assigning 80 acres to Well #5 will require an acreage adjustment to wells #2 & 3. BTA requests that a non-standard unit of 40 acres be assigned as soon as possible to the 689-C Hugh lease, wells #2 & 3, Bagley, North (Penn) Field. Notice of this request was sent by registered mail to the offset Operator requesting a waiver to rule 2 of the special rules and regulations governing the Bagley, North (Penn) Field. BTA Oil Producers proposes to drill the 689 Ltd. Hugh, Well #5, Bagley, North (Penn.) Field, Lea County, New Mexico, at the following location:

Unit Letter "L", Section 6, Township 12-S,  
Range 33-E, 1980' FSL & 510' FWL

Field rules for the Bagley, North (Penn.) field requires 80 acres to be assigned to a standard proration unit, but also provides for non-standard unit development. BTA Oil Producers proposes to reduce the acreage assigned to Wells #2 and 3 to 40 acres each and assign a standard 80 acre unit to Well #5. See attached plats for "before" and "after" acreage dedication.

BTA Oil Producers respectfully requests your waiver as an offset operator to allow BTA to assign a non-standard unit to Well #3.
