Gentlemen:

We have been advised that the above referenced well, permitted as a salt water disposal well by Division Order SWD 580, is currently being used for disposal.

An on-site inspection by an Oil Conservation Division representative confirms that the well is, and has been for an extended period of time, an active disposal well.

We have received a copy of a Federal form, dated January 26, 1995, stating the intent to convert. However, since this is not a federal lease, all sundry notices are to be submitted on Form C-103. To date, we do not have a subsequent report confirming conversion from a producing to a disposal well.

Prior to injection into the well, as stipulated in the order, a pressure test was to be conducted to confirm the integrity of the equipment. We request that you make arrangements for this test, have your personnel on location at <u>9:30 AM, AUGUST 14, 1997</u>, for this procedure.

We request that you submit a subsequent report (C-103) containing the following information:

- 1. Any repairs necessary to bring the well into a satisfactory condition for use as a salt water disposal well.
- 2. Tubing size.
- 3. Type and setting depth of packer.
- 4. Date of first injection into the well.
- 5. Volume of disposal for the first 24 hour period.
- 6. Pressure used for disposal, or note if the well is taking water on a vacuum.
