Pursuant to our telephone conversation this date, we are enclosing two copies of the Land Plat of the captioned lease. The existing roads and our proposed new road based on a verbal agreement with the surface owner are shown. In reference to surface restoration the following shall serve as our notice of intent:

1. After finishing drilling and/or completion operations, all equipment and other material not needed for further operations will be removed. The location will be cleared of all trash and junk so as to leave the wellsite in as aesthetically pleasing a condition as possible.
2. Unguarded pits, if any, containing fluids will be fenced until they have been filled.
3. If the proposed well is non-productive, all rehabilitation and/or vegetation requirements of the Bureau of Land Management and the United States Geological Survey will be complied with and will be accomplished as expeditiously as possible. All pits will be filled and leveled within 90 days after abandonment, or as soon as feasible after the pits have dried.
