A form C-104 (Request for Allowable and Authorization to Transport Oil and Natural Gas) was approved on the subject well on January 25, 1983. The well continued to be pumped until May 25, 1983 when it was decided that the well would never become an economical producer. All equipment was removed from the well and the well was shut in on June 19, 1983. All oil was sold from the tanks during June, 1983.

Approval was received to convert this well to saltwater disposal from the State of New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on June 01, 1983 (Order SWD - 258). Since the well is yet to be converted, we are requesting that its status be changed to "Temporarily Abandoned" until the well is converted. Once the conversion to saltwater disposal is completed, a new Sundry Notice will be submitted.
