SUBJECT: Special Rules Assigned to the Vada-Devonian Pool

Gentlemen:

According to the provisions of Division Order R-8770, effective November 1, 1988, temporary special rules are assigned to the Vada-Devonian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, which include the following:

A standard proration unit to contain 80 acres, consisting of the N/2, S/2, E/2 or the W/2 of a governmental quarter section.

Each well to to be located with 150 feet of the center of a quarter/quarter section.

A depth bracket allowable of 490 barrels of oil per day is assigned to a standard proration unit. In the event that more than one well shares a proration unit, the Operator may produce the assigned allowable from the wells in any proportion.

We request that you submit new Form C-102 dedicating a standard unit to your State 26 Well No. 1 located in Unit N of Section 26, Township 10 South, Range 33 East. It is necessary for the new C-102 to be filed with this office within 60 days of the effective date of this order.
