FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Subject well is no longer required for our Salt Water Disposal operation as we are now disposing of water in the interval 4790' to 6400' in the former producing State of New Mexico "BN" well number 1 in accordance with NMOCC order no. SW-D-40, and subject well is to be plugged and abandoned as follows:

1. Squeeze salt water disposal perforations 1260' to 1440' with 200 Sx cement; if necessary, will re-squeeze with 100 Sx stages until satisfactory squeeze job is obtained. (Will use class "C" cement).
2. Spot 16 Sx Class "C" cement in top 100' of 7" O. D. Casing. (No Casing will be recovered)
3. Install 4" steel marker extending 4' above ground level, clean location, as per New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission regulations.
