DETAILS OF WORK

It is proposed to drill this well to a total depth of approximately 9800' for completion in the Pennsylvanian formation. The following is the scheduled casing and cementing program: 375' of 11-3/4" 42# H-40 ST&C casing with cement to be circulated; 4550' of 8-5/8" 24# J-55 and 32# H-40 ST&C casing with 2400 sacks of cement; 9800' of 5-1/2" casing from 14# J-55 ST&C to 17# H-80 LT&C to be cemented with 750 sacks of cement. It is planned to core approximately 50' and take approximately 3 drill stem tests in the Pennsylvanian formation. Casing is to be set at total depth and well perforated opposite pay zones and treated as necessary.

Permission is requested to produce this well on completion.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

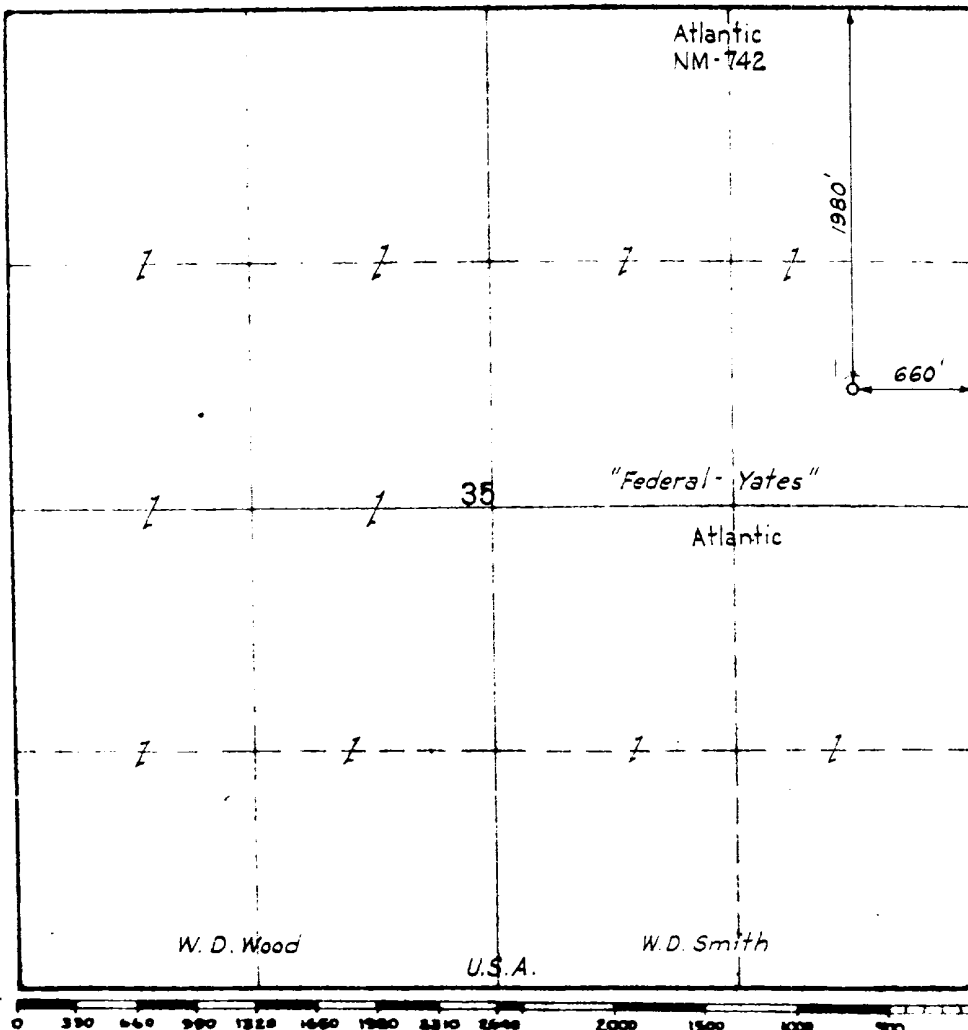
