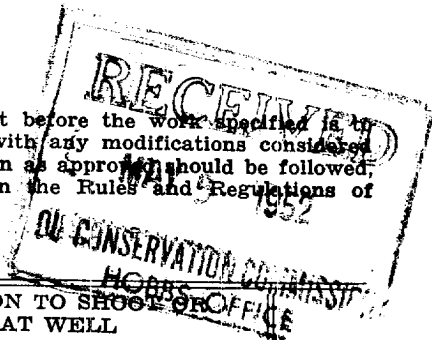

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Upon drilling to the top of San Andres, at approximately 4600', we plan on setting 5 1/2" casing at this depth and cementing with 100 sacks. We then plan on drilling with cable tools from 4600' to approximately 4800'. If the well is commercial and placed on the pump, before completing, we plan on setting a bridge plug at 2750'. Perforating casing at 2700' and displacing cement from 2700' to 2300' or through salt section.
