Report of the Commission on the Conservation of Oil
Resources of the State of Texas
Submitted to the Governor of the State of Texas
January 1, 1934

The Commission on the Conservation of Oil Resources of the State of Texas, created by Act of the Legislature of the State of Texas, Chapter 107, Acts of the 43rd Legislature, 1931, has the honor to submit herewith its report on the conservation of oil resources of the State of Texas.

The Commission was organized on July 1, 1931, and has since that time been engaged in a study of the oil resources of the State of Texas, with a view to determining the best method of conserving them for the benefit of the State and its people.

The Commission has held numerous public hearings and has received many suggestions from the public. It has also conducted extensive research into the oil industry and the conservation of oil resources.

The Commission believes that the oil resources of the State of Texas are of great value and should be conserved for the benefit of the State and its people. It believes that the best method of conserving these resources is by the establishment of a system of public control over the production and distribution of oil.

The Commission recommends that the State of Texas should establish a system of public control over the production and distribution of oil. This system should be based on the principle of conservation and should be designed to protect the oil resources of the State for the benefit of the State and its people.
