On February 2, 1952, ran 142 joints, 4590.97', of 5-1/2" OD SS casing w/2 centralizers at 4595' and 4550'. Casing in hole from bottom up: 20 joints, 647.41' 15-1/2" J-55 hydrill FJ-40, 122 joints 14" H-40 ST&C, 1 piece joint 24.03' J-55 15-1/2" H-40 on top. Set and cemented at 4600' w/160 sax neat Trinity cement by ICI. Complete at 6:00 A.M. 2-2-52.

Gulf temperature survey top cement at 3950' down from rotary bushing.

Propose to drill plug and test casing shut-off at 6:00 A.M. 2-2-52.
