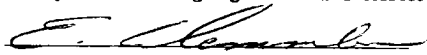

Because the Allison Penn pay zone was no longer economical to produce, the Penn Perfs at 9714-9730' were abandoned by capping the Baker retainer packer at 9682' with 16' of cement then installing a bridge plug at 4900' and capping same with 10' of cement to 4890'. An attempt to complete in the San Andres through casing perfs 4848-4874' ended in failure as the interval proved non-productive. The well was then plugged and abandoned by the following process:

1. A 13 sack cement plug 4848-4874';
2. Displaced hole with fresh water gel mud;
3. Severed 5 1/2" OD casing at 3450' and recovered same;
4. Spot 35 sack cement plug 3500-3400' over severed casing;
5. Spot 16 sack cement plug 50' to surface;
6. Erect 4" pipe marker over well with name and location;
7. Well site is ready for final inspection.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid content, not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.

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
