This well was temporarily abandoned on July 9, 1951. The following strings of casing were left in the hole:

9-5/8" set @ 345' w/225 sax.
7" set @ 4368' w/600 sax.

Total depth was 4397'. It is proposed to re-enter this well and drill 7-7/8" hole to 8,000'. 5-1/2" casing will be cemented if tests find oil in commercial quantities.
