Laid plug #1 from 9,672' to 9,542' using 25 sacks Portland El Toro cement Neat. Mixed and pumped 30 sacks MilGel with 30 barrels fresh water. Came out of hole with tubing. Ran free point. Found casing partially stuck at 4,800'. Cut casing at 6,500'. Circulated hole with heavy laden mud. Unable to pull pipe free. Cut casing at 4,805'. Came out of hole with casing. Went in hole with tubing. Laid plug #2 from 6,520' to 6,198' using 35 sacks Portland El Toro cement. Laid plug #3 from 4,820' to 4,724' using 25 sacks Portland El Toro cement Neat. Laid plug #4 from 4,345' to 4,257'. Filled hole with heavy laden mud between plugs. Came out of hole with tubing. Laid plug #5 at surface using 10 sacks Portland El Toro cement Neat. Welded cap on top of casing and installed well marker. The 13-3/8" O.D. surface casing set to 4,26' and the 8-5/8" O.D. protective casing set to 4,330' and 4,948' of the 5 1/2" O.D. casing from 4,805' to 9,750' was left in hole. Notification will be made by letter as soon as location is leveled and debris is picked up for final inspection.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
