DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Hole was bridged at 2583' and cement plug was dumped from 2583' to 2568'. Hole was filled with heavy mud. 7" O.D. Casing was shot at 1750', 1500', 1300', 1050', 900' and 755'. 755' of casing was pulled from well. Cement plug was pumped into well by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company, from 240' to 300'. Surface casing was plugged at top with cement and 4" pipe was set above ground 4' as marker.
