On February 19, 1991, Enserch Exploration, Inc., received notification that Communitization Agreement (CA) No. SW-568 was in the process of being terminated unless verification was received that the 2-N.M. (55) Federal was capable of production in paying quantities. Enserch has determined that this well is not economical to us and that we would like to have the opportunity to sell this well to another operator that would find the well to be economically beneficial to them. Therefore, we are asking that the No. 2-N.M. (55) Federal be classified as a Temporarily Abandoned well. This will allow for the appropriate paperwork to be completed and an attempt to divest the well to be made.
