

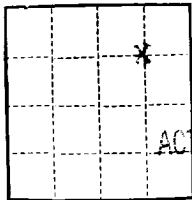

Spot 35 sk cement plug through and above perforations 4822-4976'.
Cut off 4-1/2" casing @ 4100' and pull. Spot 50 sk cement plug @ casing stub and base of intermediate (8-5/8") casing @ 4020'.
Spot 10 sk plug @ surface, install dry hole marker, clean up location for inspection.
