In compliance with New Mexico Oil & Gas Conservation Commission Order R-3153, we plan to re-enter this well and set a packer on tubing at 4190' separating the Todd Lower San Andres "B Zone" from the Todd Upper San Andres "A Zone". This well was originally completed January 17, 1965 flowing 4,650 MCF gas per day through 18/64" choke after acid treatment. The Todd Upper San Andres "A Zone" was perforated at selected intervals from 4089'-4181', treated w/2000 gallons acid, and showed little or no response. The Todd Lower San Andres was perforated at selected intervals from 4204'-4249' and treated with 3000 gallons acid. It is believed that most, if not all, production is from the Lower Zone. After this work is completed, the Todd Lower San Andres will be produced through the tubing and the Todd Upper San Andres produced through the annulus.

## Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 1: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
