Well was drilled to total depth of 3961'. Hole was lost. Will junk and abandon as follows:

At 1600' set a 50 sack plug, at base of 8-5/8" set a 25 sack plug and a 25 sack plug at surface. Will set marker. No casing will be removed as cement was circulated. 8-5/8" casing set from surface to 299'. 10# 300 viscosity mud will be placed between plugs. Well site will be in condition for final inspection in approximately 45 days.

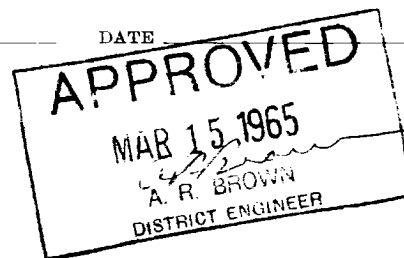

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. The form may be used for submitting proposals to perform operations on lands owned or controlled by the Federal Government, or on lands owned or controlled by the State, or on lands owned or controlled by the local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; a separate well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
