(See attached well inclination survey and Sperry-Sun Directional Survey Report.) Ran 4 1/2" N80 & J-55, 11.600, LTHC, casing to Total Depth. Cemented with 150 sacks cement. Top cement 8450 feet behind pipe. Drilled to 9475 feet. No shows at Total Depth. Plug and abandoned.

Plug No. 1 9365 to 9165 (Note TD 4 1/2 casing 9315 feet)

Plug No. 2 7100 to 6970 (Note 4 1/2" casing shot off at 7060 feet.
Top Abs 7054 feet)Plug No. 3 3490 to 3370 (Note shoe of 8 5/8" casing at 3440 feet.
Left all 8 5/8" casing in well)

Plug No. 4 10 sacks in top 8 5/8" casing.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
