IN COMPLIANCE WITH NEW MEXICO OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION COMMISSION ORDER X-3153, I PLAN TO REENTER THIS WELL AND SET A FORMATION PACKER ON TUBING AT 4195' TO SEPARATE THE TODD UPPER SAN ANDRES "A" ZONE FROM THE TODD LOWER SAN ANDRES "B" ZONE. THIS WELL WAS COMPLETED JULY 7, 1965 WITH AN ABSOLUTE OPEN FLOW POTENTIAL OF 420 MCF. THE WELL WAS PERFORATED WITH 1 SHOT PER FOOT AT 4100, 4135, 4181, 4202, 4208, 4212, 4216, 4220, 4234 AND 4244'. THE WELL WAS ACIDIZED WITH 3500 GALS. 15% ACID AND SUBSEQUENTLY ACIDIZED WITH 10,000 GALS. 15% ACID. THESE PERFORATIONS COVER BOTH THE "A" AND "B" ZONE, AND IT IS MY INTENTION, AFTER THE PACKER HAS BEEN SET, TO TEST THE "A" AND "B" ZONES SEPARATELY; THE "B" ZONE THROUGH THE TUBING AND THE "A" ZONE THROUGH THE TUBING CASING ANNULUS. IF IT IS INDICATED THAT THE PREDOMINANCE OF GAS FLOW IS FROM EITHER OF THE TWO ZONES OR PREDOMINATELY FROM THE BOTTOM ZONE, THEN I PROPOSE TO MAKE SELECTIVE PERFORATIONS COVERING THE INTERVAL FROM 4150 TO 4190' IN THE "A" ZONE BY USE OF PACKERS, ACIDIZE THIS INTERVAL, AND ATTEMPT COMPLETION IN THE "A" ZONE, DUAL WITH THE "B" ZONE, IF THE "B" ZONE WARRANTS SUCH A COMPLETION.
