TD 4690'. On 5-6-64, 4-1/2" OD 9.5# - 10.5# J-55 casing was run and set at 4690' with 200 sz cement. Tested casing with 2000 PSI for 30 minutes. Test OK. Perforated 4657'-71' W/2 SPF. Acidised with 500 gallons and fraced with 20,000 gal oil, 20,000# sand and 40,000# glass beads.

On test well pumped and flowed 114 BO X 5 BW in 24 hours thru 22/64" choke. GGR 990, CGR 30", CPT 600#, TPT 120#.

Instructions

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
