Well has not produced since October, 1977, when it was shut in because it was no longer capable of producing into a 15 psi gathering system.

The well is to be plugged and abandoned as soon as approvals by state and federal authorities are received. Estimated plugging date is 4-21-80.

The well bore is to left full of 9#/gal mud-laden fluid with cement plugs 4199'-4000' (14 sacks) and 75' to surface (10 sacks). Casing will be cut off below ground level and a standard marker attached. Surface will be restored to original contour.
