Well Dual Completed in the Slaughter "P" Zones and the Lower San Andres of the San Andres Formation as follows: The Slaughter "P" Zone was perforated 4207-4418' (Intervals) and the Lower San Andres was perforated 4676-4849' (Intervals). The two zones are separated by a Baker Model "D" Production Packer set at 4644'. The Lower Zone of this well is a Salt Water Disposal Well. Water will be injected down 2-7/8" OD Internally Plastic Coated tubing set at 4644' with Baker Model "B" Seal Assembly at 4644'. The Slaughter "P" Zone of this Dual Completion (Upper Zone) is Temporarily Abandoned.
