This well was completed 4-15-67 flowing 23 BO + 10 BWPD from perforations at 4230 to 4270 feet in the Slaughter B zone of the San Andres formation. Production has declined till it is no longer economical to produce this well (3 BO and 5 BWPD pumping). On September 9, 1971, this well was temporarily abandoned by pulling the rods and tubing, and shutting in the well. It is anticipated that this well may be used for salt water disposal at some future date.
