This well was originally drilled to a depth of 4500' in April, 1968, and completed as an oil well operated by Taylor Pruitt. See NMOCC Form C-105, dated 10-1-68, filed under the name of Marathon State, Well No. 1, Chaveroo San Andres Pool.

In September, 1968, this well was temporarily abandoned. See NMOCC Form C-103 dated 10-1-68, filed under the name of Marathon State, Well No. 1, Chaveroo San Andres Pool.

Effective November 26, 1968, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission issued to Marathon Oil Company Order No. R-3596 authorizing the disposal of produced salt water into the San Andres formation.

January 17, 1969, the 4-1/2" casing was perforated at 4163-4460', a packer was run on internally plastic lined tubing and set at 4110'. The tubing-casing annulus was then loaded with corrosion inhibited brine water.
