Gentlemen:

On January 12, 1973, you notified this office that the locations for your plugged and abandoned State 30 Wells Nos. 1, 2, and 4, all located in Section 30, T-7-S, R-33-E, had been cleared and levelled, and were ready for inspection. Subsequently, an inspection was made and it was found that the deadmen had not been removed, and that there was trash on all the locations. You were notified of this fact on May 24, 1973, and a copy of the letter is attached. However, to date we have had no response from you.

Please immediately inspect these locations, do whatever work is necessary to comply with the Rules and Regulations of the Commission, and notify this office when the work has been done.

Further, on April 26, 1973, this office approved a Notice of Intent to Plug for Well No. 3 located in Unit L of Section 30, T-7-S, R-33-E, but no subsequent report covering the plugging and abandoning of the well has been submitted. If the well has been plugged, please submit Form C-103 covering the plugging; if it has not been plugged, please submit Form C-103 indicating the present status and your future plans for the well.

On 12/15/54, the FBI received a letter from the American Friends Service Committee (AFSC) regarding the activities of the AFSC in the United States. The letter stated that the AFSC was a non-profit organization that was engaged in various social service activities, including the distribution of food and clothing to the poor. The letter also stated that the AFSC was engaged in the distribution of literature and other materials that were critical of the United States government. The FBI was concerned that the AFSC was engaged in activities that were subversive to the United States government and requested that the AFSC provide information regarding its activities.
