The inclusion of two additional gas wells within an existing 240-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit in the Bluitt-San Andres Associated Pool comprising the W/2 NW/4 and the SW/4 of Section 18, Township 8 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

Dear Ms. Husband:

My review of your letter dated October 25, 2000 concerning Saga's proposal to include the Bluitt SA "18" Federal Wells No. 12 and 14 into the subject 240-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit approved by Division Administrative Order NSP-1682-A (L) (SD), dated April 6, 1995, indicates that both wells are unorthodox pursuant to **Rule 2 (b)** of the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Bluitt-San Andres Associated Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-5353, as amended. Therefore, an application with adequate notification will be required pursuant to **Rule 2 (c)** of the "General Rules and Regulations for the Associated Oil and Gas Pools of Northwest and Southeast New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Bluitt-San Andres Associated Pool," also set forth in Division Order No. R-5353, as amended.
