Reference is made to your application dated January 17, 1995 for an 80-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Bluitt-San Andres Associated Pool:

ROOSEVELT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO <u>TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM</u> Section 19: W/2 NE/4.
