The inclusion of an additional infill gas well within an existing 320-acre standard gas spacing and proration unit in the Bluitt-San Andres Associated Pool comprising the S/2 of Section 13, Township 8 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

Dear Ms. Husband:

My review of your letter dated October 25, 2000 concerning Saga's proposal to include the Bluitt SA "13" Federal Well No. 14 into the subject 320-acre standard gas spacing and proration unit indicates that this well is unorthodox pursuant to Rule 2 (b) of the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Bluitt-San Andres Associated Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-5353, as amended. Therefore, an application with adequate notification will be required pursuant to Rule 2 (c) of the "General Rules and Regulations for the Associated Oil and Gas Pools of Northwest and Southeast New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Bluitt-San Andres Associated Pool," also set forth in Division Order No. R-5353, as amended.
