Union Oil of California at this time requests you grant our petition for an unorthodox location exception and reduced proration unit size of 160 acres in the Bluitt San Andres Associated Field for the Union Oil of California, Federal 18 #2 located 660' FSL & 660' FEL, Sec 18, T-8-S, R-38-E, Roosevelt County, New Mexico.

We have successfully recompleted the above mentioned well in the Bluitt San Andres Field. This well now requires reclassification from oil to gas well in the Bluitt San Andres Associated Field.

The spacing and acreage requirements for the Bluitt San Andres Associated Field are different for those required for the oil field. To meet the requirements of the gas field we are required to file for an unorthodox location exception and reduced proration unit size of 160 acres for the above mentioned wells.
