On Dec. 21, 1970 ran 185.58' of 4-1/2" 14 lb. flush joint liner w/Texas Pattern casing guide shoe w/float valve & Brown Well Service 5-1/2" X 4" liner hanger. Liner stuck 18' below end of 5-1/2" casing. Worked on stuck liner, spotted acid & pulled on stuck liner. Backed off stuck liner on Dec. 22, 1970 & ran jars w/accelerator sub and recovered stuck liner as run. Ran 4-3/4" bit and worked bit below 5-1/2" casing but didn't hit tight spot. On Dec. 28th ran 212.38' (overall) of 4" O.D. 9.5 lb. flush jnt. liner w/float shoe & float collar and landed at 4832' w/top of hanger at 4520' (84' above end of 5-1/2" csg.) Cemented liner w/45 sks. Chem-Comp cement mixed 14.8 to 15.3 lbs/gal. Displaced cement w/22 bbl. wt., bumped plug w/1500 Psi, floats held o.k. unscrewed from liner & reversed 3 bbl. cement from top of liner. Pressure tested casing & liner w/1500 Psi. for 10 min. before starting to drill cement on Dec. 29, 1970,

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
