Gentlemen:

The above captioned well was drilled at a standard location for an oil well as follows:

1980' FSL and 660' FEL of Sec. 15,
T8S, R37E, Roosevelt County, NM


Upon reaching a total depth of 4815', the San Andres oil zone was found to be water bearing. The well was plugged back to 4740' and completed through perforations 4630-4730 as a gas well. Four-point back pressure and other completion information have been filed with the U.S.G.S.

As the above location is non-standard, it is requested that administrative approval be given for the location of this well.

The original form C-102 dedicated 40 acres to the well. Please advise whether this well is considered in the East Bluit San Andres Associated field with 320-acre spacing or a Wildcat with 160-acre spacing. Upon receipt of this information, a new plat with the correct acreage allocation will be filed.

A gas contract is now being negotiated and some of the conditions are dependent upon the approval and acreage dedication.
