- 12-12 Run tbg to 4220, circ hole w/100 bbls mud.
- 12-13 Spot 30 sx cmt 4200-4125, spot 38 sx cmt 2260-2150, POH, cut off well head, weld on 8 5/8 left nipple, worked csg., ran free point, 100% stuck at 720, 100% free @ 715, jet cut @ 715. Pull 8 5/8 csg.
- 12-14 Pull 11' of csg, stuck, pull w/150,000 #, stuck, circ hole.
- 12-15 Etab. circ w/fresh wtr., worked csg free. Recover 715'. Ran 2 7/8 tbg to 760, spot 50 sx cmt. 760 to 735, raise tbg., spot 60 sx cmt 470 to 370. Pull (over)

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. This is local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
