

MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

H. L. BROWN, JR.
WELL NO. 1 FEDERAL "G"
990' FNL and 990' FNL, Sec. 3, 8-S, 37-E
Roosevelt County, New Mexico
Lease New Mexico 18240-A and 23018

This plan is submitted with the Application for Permit to Drill the above described well. The purpose of the plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved, and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operation so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

1. EXISTING ROADS:

- A. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a highway map showing the location of the proposed well as staked. Approximately 8 1/2 miles east of Milnesand on State Highway 262, just before the Highway makes a sharp right-angle turn to the South, turn in North across a cattleguard on a lease road. An H. L. Brown, Jr. sign is located at this turn-off. The lease road makes a right turn and proceeds East one mile from the turn-off to a North-South road. Turn North approximately 600 feet then the road veers Northeast approximately one mile to a caliche pit and windmill. Turn East at the windmill through a cattleguard to the location on the immediate right. No new road will be necessary.
- B. Exhibit "B" is a plat showing all existing roads within a one-mile radius of the wellsite.
- C. There are no plans to improve or repair any of the existing roads at this time; however, this is an area where H. L. Brown, Jr. operates nine gas wells and the existing roads have been maintained in the past and that practice will continue in the future.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROADS:

- A. Length and Width: There is an existing road within 100 feet of the well location. Construction of the location pad will extend to the road. This is the lease road that connects the H. L. Brown, Jr. Federal "E" and Federal "F" wells.
