

MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

H. L. BROWN, JR.
WELL NO. 1 FEDERAL "J"
1650' FNL and 1650' FEL, Sec. 10, 8-S, 37-E

This plan is submitted with the Application for Permit to Drill the above described well. The purpose of the plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved, and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operation so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

1. EXISTING ROADS:

- A. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a highway map showing the location of the proposed well as staked. Approximately twelve miles east of Milnesand on State Highway 262, turn in North across a cattle-guard on a lease road towards a cluster of ranch houses and barns. An H. L. Brown, Jr. sign is located at this turn-off. The lease road makes a left turn and proceeds North 1/4 mile from the turn-off to a "tee"(intersection). Turn West approximately 1/4 miles then the road veers North approximately 1/2 mile to an abandoned well location on the East side of the road. Turn East along a flagged route approximately 2,000' to the proposed location.
- B. Exhibit "B" is a plat showing all existing roads within a one-mile radius of the wellsite.
- C. There are no plans to improve or repair any of the existing roads at this time; however, this is an area where H. L. Brown, Jr. operates nine gas wells and the existing roads have been maintained in the past and that practice will continue in the future.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROADS:

- A. Length and Width: New road required will be twelve feet wide and approximately 2,000' long. This new road is labeled and color coded red on Exhibit "B". The center line of the proposed new road from the beginning to the wellsite, has been staked and flagged with the stakes being visible from any one to the next.
