2. Dump 30' cement on top of CIBP.
3. Load casing with treated water (corrosion and scale inhibitors) and pressure test to 500 psi and hold for 30 minutes.
4. MOC will notify the BLM office in Roswell, NM 48 hours prior to witness test.
