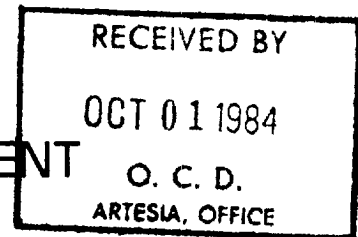

The subject case was first set to be heard at the August 22, 1984 Division Examiners Hearing pursuant to the written request from you received by this office on July 20, 1984. The advertisement and docket for this particular case appeared as follows:

"CASE 8303:

Application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for an exception to Rule 2(B) of Division Order R-1670-I, Roosevelt County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an exception to Rule 2(B) of Division Order R-1670-I to permit applicant to complete its well at an unorthodox oil well location 990 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 21, Township 8 South, Range 38 East, Bluit-San Andres Associated Pool, the N/2 NW/4 of said Section 21 to be dedicated to the well."

This case was continued to September 19, 1984, at your request during a telephone conversation between myself and you. During that conversation you requested changes to this case. That particular advertisement and docket for this case reads as follows:
