Hanson Operating Company, Inc. is proposing to plug and abandon the above well in the following manner:

1. Set a CIBP with 35' of cement to isolate Bough "C" perforations(9438' - 9460').
2. Set a 200' cement plug at the top of the Tubb formation at 6822'.
3. Set a CIBP with 35' of cement to isolate the proposed San Andres perforations (4743' - 4888'), at 4700'.
4. Set a 150' cement plug at the 8 5/8" casing shoe at 4200'.
5. Attempt to cut off and remove the 5 1/2" casing at 3400'. Set a 100' cement plug at the top of the cut off 50' in the 5 1/2" casing and 50' out in the 8 5/8" casing.
6. Set a 100' cement plug at the 13 3/8" casing shoe at 495'.
7. Set a 50' cement plug at surface.
8. Remove all equipment and install a dry hole marker.

All plugs will be set in place using 10# of mud ladden fluid. All cement plugs will be Premium Plus.

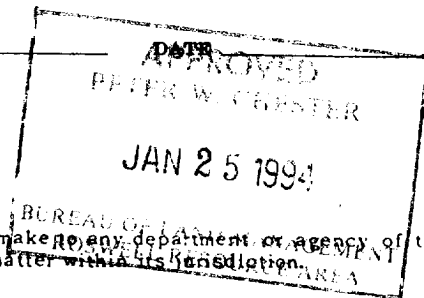
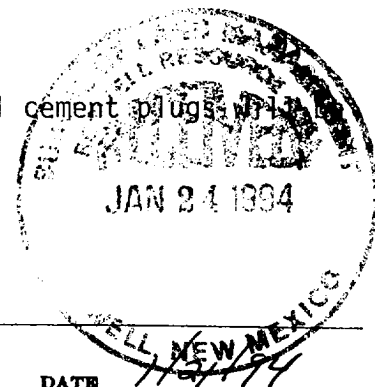

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
