On 10-31-68 moved in, rigged up, removed dry hole marker, drilled and circulated from 0'-8009' T.D. Ran 166 jts. 5 1/2" 15.5# & 20# csg. for liner, set from 4266'-7960', cem. w/400 sx Howco lite and 150 sx neat, lost returns. Squeezed liner top w/200 sx reg. cem. Circulated and drilled into liner top at 4266', pressured up on liner top w/1000#, found leak. Ran packer, pressured up on liner top, communicated, closed csg., tested pipe, tbg., and csg. w/1500#, dropped to 500# in 28 min. Controlled csg. pressure at 1000#, pumped against liner top w/4000#, unable to break down, assume leak in 7-5/8" csg. Drilled and circulated 7848'-8009' T.D. Acidized open hole 7960'-8009' w/10,000 gal. 15% acid. Rigged down 11-15-68.

On 1-26-69 moved in, rigged up, ran 155 jts. 2-7/8" EUE J-55 plastic coated tbg. w/Baker Model "R" packer. Tbg. set at 7938', packer set at 7934'. Loaded tbg. - csg. annulus w/240 bbls. fresh water. Rigged down 1-27-69.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
