No. 2, 12-30-54 - 1 hour Howco DST from 3914-4025' - 1" surface choke, 1" choke at 3888' - Packers at 3914' & 3906' - Bombs at 4024' & 3892' - Jars at 3899' - ~~Packers at 3914'~~ Tool opened ~~11~~ 3:20PM - Weak blow air 15 minutes, dead 45 minutes - Started out of hole with tools - Packer stuck - Resulting fish job destroyed pressure charts.

No. 3, 1-9-55 - 1 hour Howco DST from 4800-4833' - 1" surface choke, 1" choke at 4775' - Packers at 4792' & 4800' - Bombs at 4779' & 4882' - Jars at 4786' - Tool opened 11:PM - Weak blow air 5 minutes, dead 55 minutes - Recovered 20' drilling mud, no shows - HP 2435# - FP 0# - 15 minute BHP 0#.

No. 4, 2-5-55 - 1 hour Howco DST from 7249-7289' - 1" surface choke, 1" choke at 7186' - Packers at 7241' & 7249' - Bombs at 7190' & 7287' - Jars at 7235' - Tool opened 3:35PM - Very weak blow air 5 minutes, dead 55 minutes - Recovered 10' drilling mud, no shows - HP 3810# - FP 0# - 15 minute BHP 0#.

No. 5, 2-10-55 - 1 hour Howco DST from 7400-7586' - 1" surface choke, 1" choke at 7378' - Packers at 7392' & 7400' - Bombs at 7578' & 7582' - Jars at 7383' - Tool opened 2:AM - Weak blow air 12 minutes, dead 48 minutes - Recovered 20' drilling mud, no shows - HP 3800# - FP 100# - 15 minute BHP 100#.

No. 6, 2-14-55 - 1 hour Howco DST from 7721-7795' - 1" surface choke, 1" choke at 7694' - Packers at 7713' & 7721' - Bombs at 7700' & 7793' - Jars at 7705' - Tool opened 2:10AM - Good blow air decreasing, dead at end of test - Recovered 996' fluid, 50' drilling mud, 400' oil & gas cut drilling mud, cut 5% oil, & 546' salt water - HP 3860# - FP 190-455# - 15 minute BHP 940#.

No. 7, 2-16-55 - 1 hour Halliburton DST from 7850-7902' - 1" surface choke, 1" choke at 7826' - Packers at 7842' & 7850' - Bombs at 7830' & 7900' - Jars at 7836' - Tool opened 12:01AM - Very weak blow air 10 minutes, dead 50 minutes - Recovered 20' drilling mud, no shows - HP 3765# - FP 0# - 15 minute BHP 0#.
