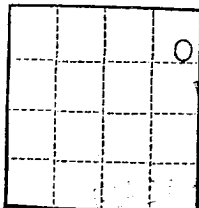

(Bottom of surface casing, 9 5/8") and set 10 sack plug @ top of 9 5/8" casing. Set a 4" marker 5' above the ground properly labeled and will level and clean location as to properly conform with the contours of the ground.
