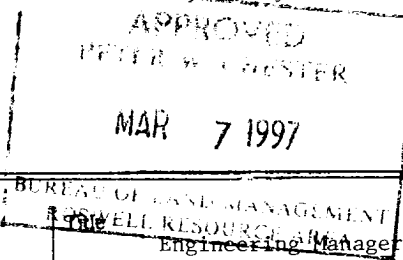
13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operation (clearly state all pertinent details, including estimated starting date of any proposed work and approximate duration thereof. If the proposal is to deepen directionally or recompleat horizontally, give subsurface locations and measured and true vertical depths of all pertinent markers and zones. The Peery Federal #2 currently produces 780 mcf/d/2 bc/d/0 bw/d @ 300# FTP into a 35 psig GPM operated gas transportation line. GPM plans to shutdown its Linam Ranch Plant March 3, 1997 to March 5, 1997.

Pursuant to a telephone conversation between Mr. Pete Chester of the BLM and Joel Martin, in which Martin requested and received approval to vent the gas from the subject well during the plant shut-down, this Sundry Notice is to document the conversation and our plan of operations:

Beginning on Saturday, March 1, 1997, NGP will gradually choke back the well to 550 to 600 mcf/d (severe load-up could occur below those rates), and will vent the gas downstream of the GPM at the tank battery during the plant shut-down. The well will be returned to sales immediately after the plant comes on-line.

In the event that we cannot keep the well unloaded at 550-600 mcf/d, we may have to vent 780 mcf/d, but we will attempt to curtail to 550-600 mcf/d.
