Tested 13 1/8" CD casing with 600 PSI for 30 minutes from 11:30 P.M. to 12:00  
midnite. Tested O.K. Job complete February 21, 1959. Drilled cement plug and  
re-tested with 600 PSI for 30 minutes from 1:00 A.M. to 1:30 A.M. February 22,  
1959. Tested O.K. Job complete 1:30 A.M. February 22, 1959.
