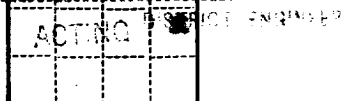

DETAILS OF WORK

Drill 17" hole to 500' (approximately 20' into the Red Beds) & set 13 1/8" casing, circulated cement to surface.

Drill 12 1/4" hole to 2900' (approximately 45' into the San Andres) & set 9 5/8" casing, circulate cement to surface.

Drill to the pre-Cambrian at approximately 12,200' & based upon evaluation of Devonian & Ellenburger, set 5 1/2" casing at approximately 11,250' or 12,200'. Sufficient cement will be used to cover all productive zones.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
