FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The above well was drilled to a total depth of 11,750' in lime without encountering commercial quantities of oil or gas in any zone penetrated. We therefore propose to plug and abandon this well as follows: Spot 25 sack cement plugs at the following depths: the intervals being filled with heavy laden mud. 11680-11620; 10,000-9940; 8380-8320; 4660-4600; 3460-3400. Shoot off and pull approximately 900' 9 5/8" casing, spot a 25 sack cement plug in the casing stub and place a 25 sack cement plug to surface. A 4" pipe marker will be erected and the location restored to its original contour in accordance with existing New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission regulations.
