DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools at the above location to a total depth of approximately 11,500'. All casing will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 13 3/8" casing to be set at approximately 350' and cemented with approximately 350 sacks cement to be circulated to surface; 9 5/8" casing to be set at approximately 3,000' and cemented with approximately 1,500 sacks cement; 7" casing to be set at approximately 11,500' and cemented with approximately 600 sacks cement. Casing to be perforated opposite the pay zone.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
