## DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded July 4, 1963, and drilled 12-1/4" hole to total depth of 320 feet.

Run and cemented 10 jts. (305.92') 8-5/8", 24#, J-55, new, ann. casing at 316.92' with 175 sz. reg. cnt. with 4% gel and 2% calcium chloride added. Cement Circulated. C.I.P. at 8:45 p.m., July 4, 1963. Waited on cement 18 hours. Tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes. OK.

Drilled 6-3/4" hole to total depth of 3205 feet. Run and cemented 103 jts. & 1 pc. (3195.37') 4-1/2", 9.5#, J-55, new casing at 3205.27' with 300 sz. reg. cnt. with 18% salt by wt. & 0.8% Baid 9 added. C.I.P. at 7:45 a.m., July 9, 1963. Waited on cement 18 hours. Tested casing with 1000# for 30 mins. OK. Placed well on water injection July 12, 1963. Refer to MSEC order No. 187X-138 dated 6-10-63. This well part of unit waterflood project.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
