Receipt is acknowledged of your "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated November 1, 1955, covering your well No. 6-17 Federal-Medlin located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , section 17, T. 15 S., R. 31 E., Caprock-Queen Field, Chavez County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is hereby approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the "Oil and Gas Operating Regulations" revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which will be sent you on request and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. Notify this office in sufficient time to arrange for a representative to witness the cementing operations and water shut off tests.
3. Furnish this office with a sample description log from the base of the salt to the total depth, and/or, copies of any electric logs or surveys run, in addition to four copies of our log of oil or gas well, form 9-330.
4. The surface casing shall be cemented at approximately 300 feet or the oil string shall be two staged.
