Dear Mr. McNaughton:

In the absence of Mr. S. J. Stanley I am replying to your letter relative to the drilling and casing program for your Neville G. Penrose, Inc. A. L. Estate #1 wildcat well in SW SW Sec. 20-15S-31E, Chaves County, New Mexico.

It is my opinion that you should run a minimum of 300 ft. of surface casing and cement to surface, and since there is a prior potash lease the oil string of casing should be cemented back to a point above the top of the salt and you must furnish this Commission with a copy of a temperature survey indicating the top of the cement.

Also forward three copies of a surveyor's plat verifying the location of this wildcat well in compliance with Oil Conservation Commission Rule #1104.
